An Inter class holiday homework Exhibition Competition was organised by the school authorities with the blessings of Pujya Maharaj Ji and Guru MAA Ji on 07.07.2023 in the school campus. It was arranged caderwise Bloomingdale, Primary, Middle and Secondary levels. A pannel of judges was set up with some parametres to assess the creativity of students and to state positions at different levels.

Main attractions were:-

Mandala Painting:-It is a form of artistic expression that involves creating intricate and symmetrical designs known as mandalas. It is carved on canvas or a sheet of paper, acrylic or watercolor paints. Students used traditional mandalas for concentric circles and geometric patterns also explored more organic or abstract designs.

Marvel Paintings:- It refers to artwork that is inspired by the characters, stories, and universe of Marvel Comics. Students used this art for popular characters such as Spider-Man, Iron Man, Hulk, Black Widow etc.

Fabric Painting:- It refers to the practice of creating designs, patterns, or illustrations directly on fabric using specialized fabric paints or dyes. Students used free hand painting ,tie-dyeing where fabric is folded, twisted, or tied before dyeing to create unique patterns.

Mosaic Painting/Art: It involves creating images or patterns by assembling small, colorful pieces of materials such as glass, ceramic tiles, stones or other objects.

Scratch painting/Scratch Board Art: - It is a technique that involves creating images by scratching away the top layer of a specially prepared surface to reveal a different color or texture underneath. It is often used for illustrations, greeting cards, bookmarks, and other art projects.

Paper Collage Painting:- It involves creating artwork by assembling and adhering various pieces of paper onto a surface to form a composition.

The above mentioned different arts and paintings were used by the students under the mentorship of **Mr. Rajesh Chauhan Ji and Ms. Sheetal Thereja Ji** to show their creativity unique and idiosyncratic.

The purpose of an inter-class holiday homework exhibition was to

- 1. Encourage creativity: Students get a chance to express their creativity by presenting their work in unique and innovative ways. They can use different mediums and materials to create visually appealing projects.
- 2. Promote learning: The exhibition reinforces the learning that took place during the holiday period. Students can explain their projects to others, helping them solidify their understanding of the topics covered.
- 3. Enhance presentation skills: Presenting their work in front of an audience helps students develop their public speaking and presentation skills. They learn to articulate their thoughts clearly and confidently.
- 4. Foster collaboration and competition: The exhibition encourages healthy competition among students, motivating them to put in extra effort and produce high-quality work. It also provides an opportunity for collaboration and teamwork if students have worked on group projects.
